All accepted lectures and posters will be published in the Congress Proceedings, which will be available at the registration desk. Selected contributions will be published in Elsevier special issues of *Trends in Food Science & Technology* (reviews) and *Innovative Food Science & Emerging Technologies* (original papers).

The 3-page extended abstract in English (references and illustrations included) can exclusively be submitted as a doc-file attached to an e-mail sent to abstract@uni-hohenheim.de. Submissions are welcome from November 1 till December 15, 2005. The authors will receive an acknowledgement of receipt via e-mail.

The manuscript layout is mandatory. A template including all relevant features together with the Contribution Assignment Page can be downloaded from the website. Contributors are kindly requested to accurately adhere to all formal aspects. Please note that each contribution must be assigned to a specific topic according to the categories provided (see 'Topics'). Also, the designated type of contribution, i.e. poster or oral presentation, shall be indicated.

During the conference three awards for the best poster presentation will be assigned by the members of the Scientific Committee.
